Jackson ASB

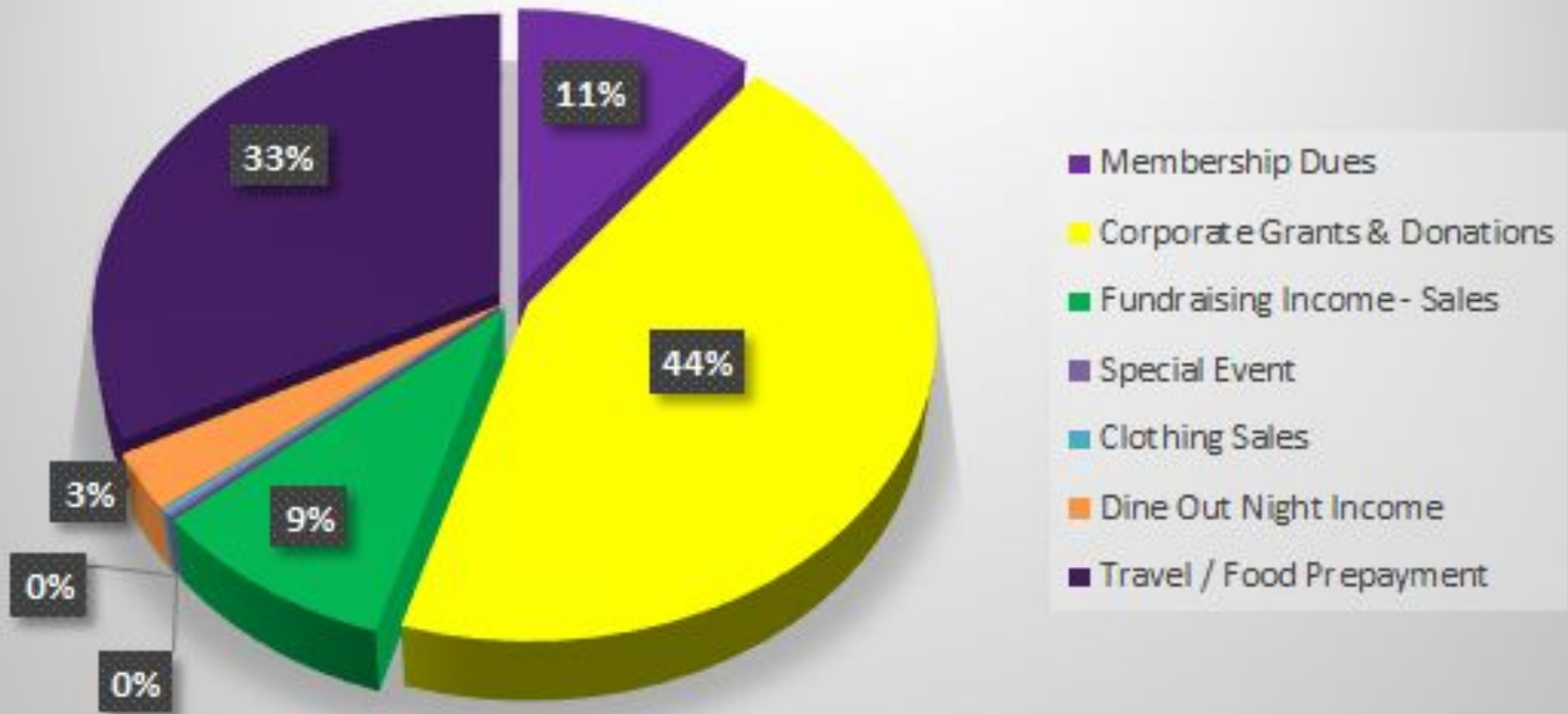
- ◆ Direct travel expenses (hotel, transportation)

Boosters 2019 Income

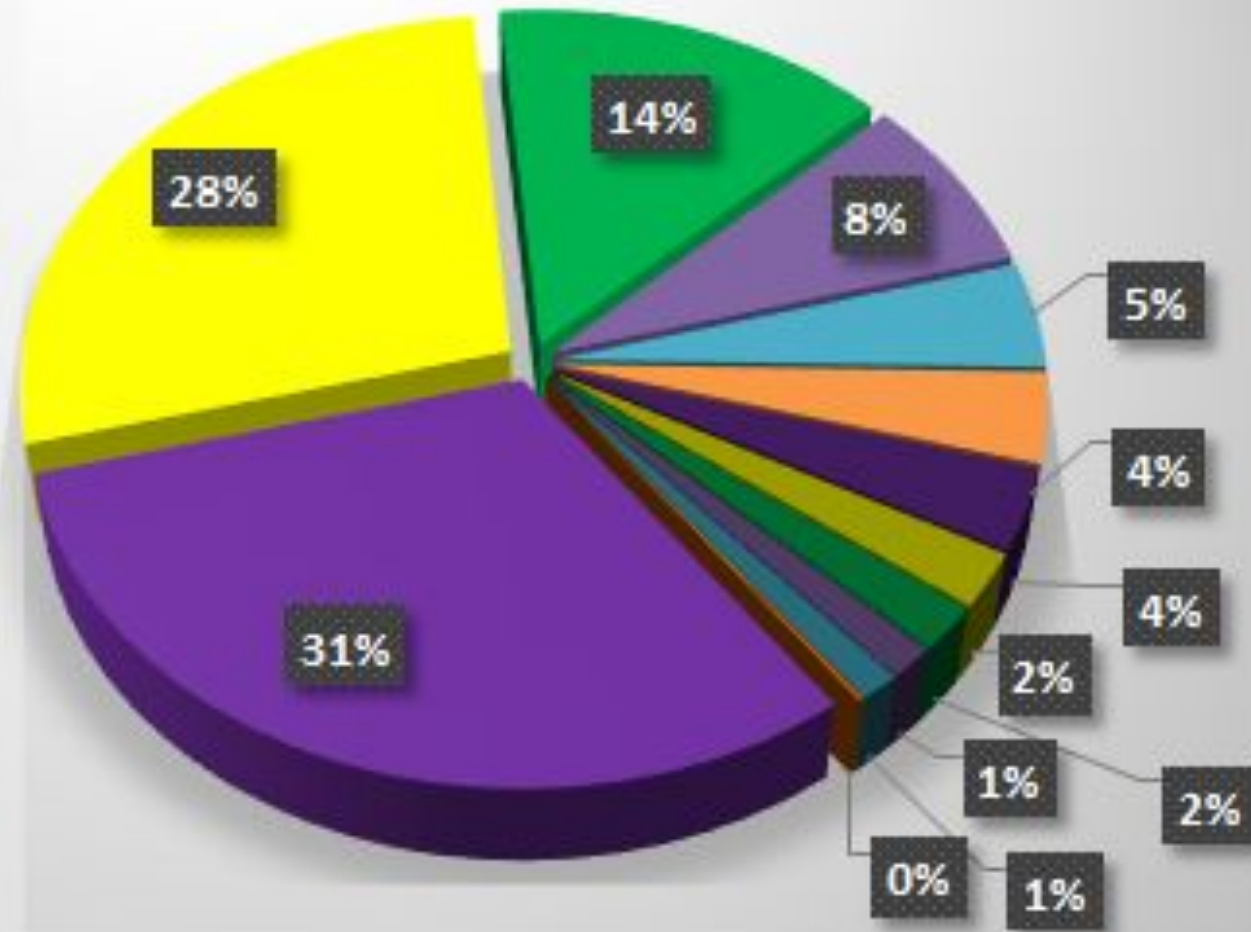
Total Income \$49,377.17
