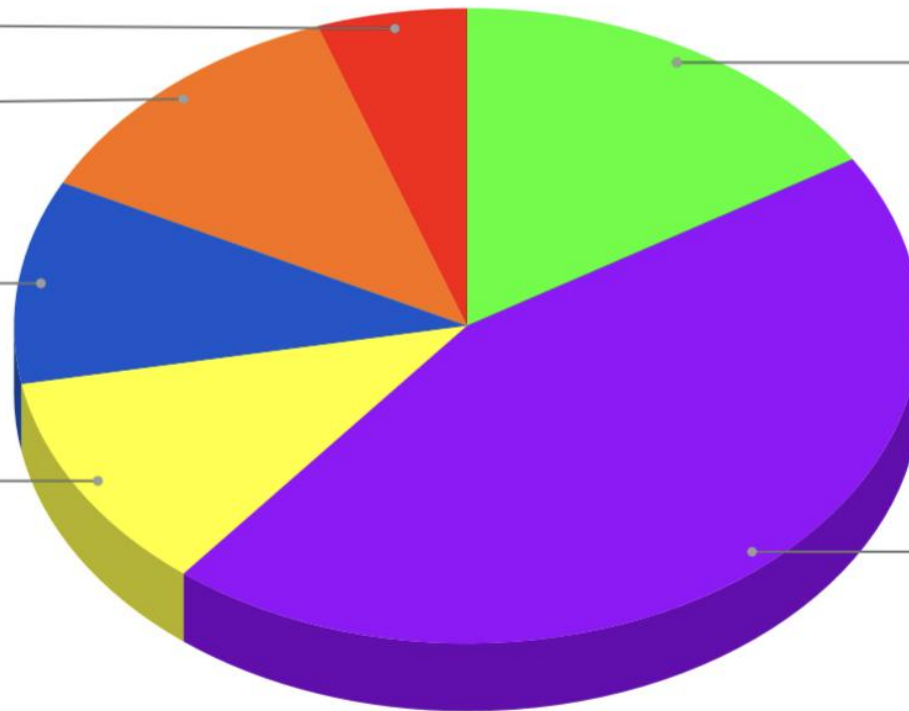

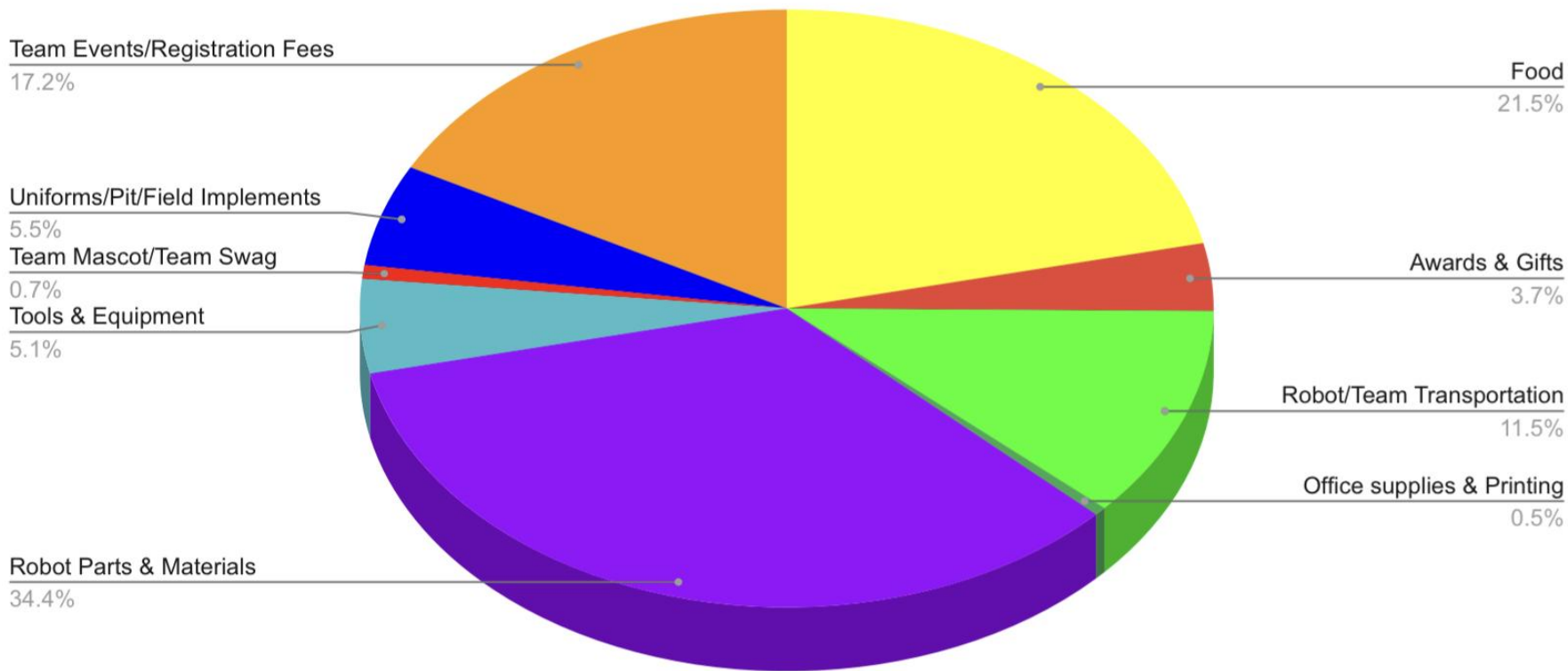

Jester's Court GameFest Fundraiser

- ◆ Student Required Support
 - ◆ Student +3 friends buy admission
 - ◆ 4 people mention student when purchasing admission
 - ◆ Promotion: posters to local schools, game shops, etc.
 - ◆ Volunteering during event
 - ◆ Buy out: \$50 donation via PayPal
